Words from our Leader

"My Ship Is Finally Coming In" (Isaiah 1:19, 20) If you be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the Land: but if you refuse and rebel; ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it.

Bless the Lord oh my soul and all that is within me. I will bless His Holy name how about you?! Let me tell you something beloved of God, it is something when you communicate with God and He allows peace to overtake you. I love God so much just because He is God! AMEN!

Being morally good is wonderful but that is not enough. Going to church is great but that is not enough. We get upset when others end up passing us by or others seem to be benefiting in areas in which you are struggling but have you thought they are doing what is necessary and just because you may not see them do does not mean that they are not doing. We want to see so that we can judge; so that we can determine who we think should or should not be; who we think is or is not. We want to see too much! In this hour family, please stop worrying about what others are doing and worry about you. You are wasting your time worried and focused on their activity and they are passing you by because your efforts and attention is on them and not on you and God.

Because of the hour that is at hand our positioning in God is so very important. We are either not doing at all, doing the right things but in the wrong season or doing the wrong things all together. I stopped by just to encourage you to let you know that your "ship is finally coming in." Thank you Jesus!

CAUTION: Ministry about to take place

To guarantee that your ship docks in your bay you must walk out the imperatives or requirements that are set before you. The outline has been structured for you, now it is up to you to follow through. The timing of God is now but are you in the right position? Timing and positioning, concerning you, now must meet together to produce "manifestation!" That is what your ship is carrying as it makes its way to your docking bay.

Beloved you have to be (1) willing and (2) obedient and then the promise. You have been informed of what is required now it is up to you. It has been a long time coming but it is finally making its way. Whether it docks at your location or not is up to you. Are you willing to take heed to be obedient to do?

Have you ever noticed in the Bible how it seems that God is always giving us an ultimatum to being the beneficiary of His blessings? For example He says if you do this then I will do that! In order to receive what He has or is offering then there is a requirement or prerequisite that one must follow. I do know that God is a loving God and He is a faithful God and He makes provisions for me and you even in our disobedience to what He has required of us to do. That is true "love". Love is the heart of God's very nature. Might I submit this to you for your understanding in that the love of God is the perfection of His affection He has for us which causes Him to give of Himself to us on a continual basis?! The love that He has for us is not merely an emotion but it is an act of His "WILL!"

In order to become the beneficiary of "what is good" outlined in Micah and the "good of the land" outlined in Isaiah, we must be willing to be found in His will. What is it to be willing you might ask? To be willing suggests that: we are consenting, inclined or ready to proceed in a motion that is lateral in order to accomplish a proposed scenario. To be willing means that we agree not with our flesh but with the Spirit of God that reigns within us. To be willing says that I forsake my wants and desires and yield to the things of God. To be willing says that I have counted up the cost and I know it is not going to be easy but I have a mind to DO the will of God concerning my life. Remember the bible declares that He comes both to will and to do of His good pleasure concerning you and me. The will extracted from willing is the faculty of conscious and especially of deliberate action; the power of control the mind has over its own actions. It is the wish, purpose as carried out or the determination to do. Our will is justified in the morality of our existence. In Theology there is something called the Moral Argument and this is what it says? It says that we are moral beings and that we possess an inner sense of right and wrong as well as a sense of responsibility to adhere to what is right and avoid the wrong. This argument substantiates our will to do and not do because of the Holy Spirit that lives in us and He has three main qualities that constitute His personality and they are mind, WILL and emotions.

In order to eat the good of the land you and I must have a mind to do and to be. To be willing denounces our flesh and it invites our spirit into a realm of openness that our only pleasure is to seek to fulfill the will of God in our lives. Which means we only desire to do what becomes pleasing to Him as our Savior and our Father because of the love we have for Him. His will is not perfection but instead it is positioning. The question becomes are you willing to position yourself so that He can perfect you in every way to fulfill His will concerning your life?



When you're about to be put out for not being able to pay bills, SAY AMEN!




So stop SINGING the song and begin LIVING it!
